

Comfy Chunky Scarf

Pattern design: Karlien Pleizier



What you need:

- N (10 mm) crochet hook
- Darning needle
- Yarn:
 - ByClaire Chunky: 5 balls for the scarf, 1 additional ball for the fringes and pom-poms – two colorways: 002 Vintage Pink or 007 Petrol
 - ByClaire Softmix for the pom-poms:
 - **Colorway 1 Vintage Pink:** 015 Ice Blue, 037 Orange, 033 Yellow, 007 Fuchsia, 035 Salmon.
 - **Colorway 2 Petrol:** 027 Turquoise, 032 Lime, 023 Seagreen, 025 Emerald, 011 Lila, 016 Sky, 018 Denim
- Pom-pom maker (max diameter: 4cm)



Abbreviations:

(US Crochet terms)

- CH – Chain
- SC – Single Crochet
- BLO – Back Loops Only
- SK - Skip



Pattern:

This pattern consists of two alternating rows. You can make the scarf as long as preferred.

CH 26.

Row 1: SC in 4th CH from hook. *CH 1, SK 1, SC 1*. Repeat from * until end of row. Turn.

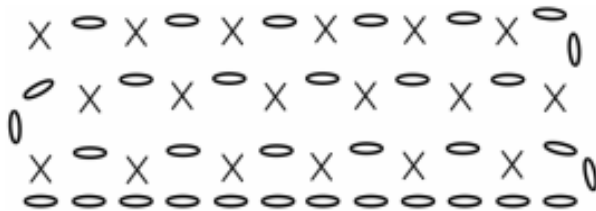
From now on, crochet in BLO (Back Loops Only) of the previous row.

Row 2: CH 2. Repeat *SC (In BLO of previous row's CH), SK 1, CH 1* until end of row.

Keep repeating row 2 until the scarf has reached the desired length.

Tip: When finishing a ball of yarn, try to change yarns at the start of a row. Because the scarf has an open structure, it will be easier to weave in loose ends along the side.

Pattern Diagram:



Finishing:

Weave in all loose ends. Tie a flat knot in adjacent ends and use the darning needle to weave in the ends along the side of the scarf.

Tip: split the yarn into 2 thinner threads to make it easier to weave in the ends inconspicuously.

Fringes:

For each fringe, cut two pieces of yarn at a length of 40cm each. Fold the threads in two to form a loop. Insert the loop in one of the CH gaps, top to bottom. Pull the ends of the threads through the loop and pull firmly. Unwind the threads for a more nonchalant look.

Pom-poms:

Make pom-poms with a diameter of 4cm each. Decide on color placement and sew the pom-poms to the scarf just above the fringes. (**Tip:** for an easy finish, pull the two longer threads of a pom-pom to the other side of the scarf and tie them together.)





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
